



Memorandum of Understanding

Objectives of International Pharmaceutical Students Federation

IPSF was founded in 1949 and is a non-profit, non-political, and non-religious volunteer organization that represents 350,000 pharmacy students and recent graduates worldwide. IPSF holds official relations with the World Health Organization (WHO), operation relations with United Nations of Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), and a roster consultative status with the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (UN ECOSOC), and works closely with many professional partner organizations.

The objective of this agreement is to cooperate with ISIC association in order to issue ISIC student identity card for IPSF members and recognize it as IPSF membership card, in order to provide students with better services via ISIC.

Objectives of ISIC

The ISIC Association has launched in 1956 an official international student identity card which is endorsed by UNESCO, national governments, ministries of education and student organisations worldwide. ISIC aims at providing its card holders with preferential services and benefits to students worldwide and to allow them to be identified as full-time students wherever they are.

The objective of this agreement is to recognise that both organisations aim to serve the students best interests at a political, academic and social level.

Mutual Aims and Gains

ISIC supports IPSF's objectives to:

- Increase the value proposition of IPSF membership to its student members
- Utilise the ISIC for identification of IPSF Student members
- Give increased leverage to its members to approach commercial organizations for support and sponsorship, aimed at them gaining financial independency

IPSF supports ISIC's objectives to -

- Be recognised as the only internationally accepted proof of full-time student status
- Increase ISIC recognition and cooperation within the Pharmaceutical student community
- Increase awareness of the ISIC and its benefits within the international student community
- Promote and assist ISIC card holders to get access to preferential services, goods and products that support students in reaching their educational, social and professional objectives
